The Anti-ragging Squads and Anti-ragging committee jointly decide the punishment and intimate to the Principal in writing for implementation.

Punishments: Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established by the Anti-Ragging Committee of the College, the possible punishments for those found guilty of ragging at the College level shall be any one or any combination of the following:

1. Cancellation of admission.
2. Suspension from attending classes.
3. Suspension / expulsion from the hostel.
4. Withholding / withdrawing scholarship and other benefits.
5. Debarring from appearing in any test / examination or other evaluation process
6. Debarring from representing the University in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival etc.
7. Handing over to police for taking necessary action as per IPC.
8. Collective punishment:- When the persons committing or abetting the crime or ragging are not identified, the College shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure community pressure on the potential raggars.
9. Any other form of punishment, if suggested.

Note : As per the instruction, each of the student of the Institute and his/her parents and, or Guardian are hereby required to submit an affidavit at the time of registration / admission, which is mandatory for admission.
